

Connectors-Membership

The overall commitment of a Connector can vary from an occasional meeting to get a Potential Member started to making monthly follow up calls to those who don't finish the process.

Ideal Connectors can be described by:

- Spiritual maturity at least at the Growing Believer level.
- Somewhat expressive; enjoys being with other people.
- Desire for others to be a part of the Church Family.
- Some administrative skills (depending on the specific tasks they choose).

Connectors are asked to do either or both:

- Meet a Potential Member to give the handbook and discuss the process.
- On a monthly basis (or select months) contact Potential Members that have passed the six-month minimum preparation period and have not followed through with the Elder Interview.

Connectors work with the Membership-Elder and should communicate any issues or concerns in a timely manner.
