

Member-Mentors

The overall commitment of a Member-Mentor may be as little as a resource to answer an occasional question, to one who meets regularly with their Potential Member(s).

Ideal Member-Mentors can be described by:

- Any member of our church; leadership role or board membership not required.
- Spiritual maturity at the fruit-bearing believer level.
- Desire for fellowship with new people or younger people.

Member-Mentors are asked to:

- Be available for Potential Member's questions related to the membership process or content.
- Ideally, attend the quarterly Membership Connection Events to support the Potential Members they Member-Mentor (when those people attend).
- Use the Participating Membership Handbook as a guide for learning. Member-Mentors are not required to "teach" but to help others "learn." Ask questions and answer questions.
- Guide Potential Members; help them prepare for the Elder Interview; if there are any concerns about whether they should move forward; bring this to the attention of the Membership Elder for their oversight and direction.
- Communicate any issues or concerns to the Membership Elder.
